Designated Home Run Hitter RuleOptional rule for invitational tournaments

Cost \$50.00 per tournament. Must name charity and be approved by Ex Board and/or Commissioner.

- 1. \$50.00 must be paid prior to invitational tournament's first game and designates one player on the roster as DHRH. Legal Pickup eligible. (Classification limitations for pickup players in invitational tournaments still apply)
- 2. DHRH must remain with original person throughout the tournament. If player is injured and no longer able to continue play in the tournament, the DHRH may be replaced only with approval of the Tournament Director. An ejection of the DHRH in any game would eliminate the DHRH for the balance of the Tournament.
- 3. DHRH does not count against the teams HR total.
- 4. If DHRH is walked intentionally, or walked when the team is out of HR's, the next player would be allowed to hit a HR for that time at bat and the DHRH rules would apply. This does not carry over to any other batters regardless of how many more are walked.
- 5. Each Invitational Tournament would provide HR Ticket/Wrist band to provide to umpire prior to each game.
- 6. All revenue produced by the DHRH must be for charitable purposes and approved by the Ex Board and or Commissioner.
